1. About ACCESS Development Services

ACCESS Development Services, a livelihood support organization head quartered at New Delhi, was founded in 2006 with support from DFID (Govt. of UK). The programming strategy of ACCESS involves building "Inclusive Value Chains" and helping the primary producers to accrue higher benefits of the value chain dynamics. ACCESS focuses its efforts in the under-served regions of the country, working with vulnerable communities like tribal, minority groups, small and marginal farmers, etc. working across both farm and non-farm livelihoods. Our core focus is also working towards women economic empowerment across our projects.

Within the farm-based livelihoods programme strategy, ACCESS works to enhance incomes of small holder farmers, integrating climate resilient agriculture practices, and promoting and building capacities of Farmer Producer Organizations. ACCESS has promoted over 185 FPOs across six states and is supporting another 100 FPOs through technical advisory and market linkage facilitation.

ACCESS has operations in 11 states, viz., Odisha, Madhya Pradesh, Assam, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Rajasthan, West Bengal, National Capital Region, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh, through ongoing 34 projects. The organization has impacted the livelihoods of 410,000 households including vulnerable communities like tribal, minority groups, excluded groups, women, small and marginal farmers, artisans and weavers.

Under an ambitious programme awarded by International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), ACCESS is managing a Fund for supporting enterprises working on Agroecology Value Chains under its Investment in Agroecology Value Chains Project (IAVCP).

2. Investments in Agroecology Value Chains Project (IAVCP)

Investments in Agroecology Value Chains Project (IAVCP) is an IFAD funded programme that focuses on identifying viable business opportunities linked to agroecology clusters and value chains, providing investment support for integrated agroecology production systems, and offering grants to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) and Producer Organization Enterprises (POE) working in agroecology value chains to support their business growth and expansion.

It aims to promote integrated sustainable production systems through grants, technical assistance and ecosystem support for MSEs and POEs. The objective is to improve their businesses, enhance their agroecological outcomes, and provide tangible benefits to small producers in the value chain. The following three aspects distinguish the IAVCP from traditional value chain investment programmes and critical for a project's suitability for investment.

Aspect # 1: Integration of Agroecological Principles

Aspect # 2: Impact on Small Holder Farmers/Small & Marginal Producers

Aspect # 3: Sustainability & Financial Viability of the Business

Focus states: Meghalaya, Nagaland, Mizoram, Assam, Odisha, Uttarakhand, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, and Chhattisgarh.

3. Scope of Work

ACCESS Development Services is releasing this Expression of Interest (EoI) to empanel individual Consultants in two categories — (i) as Business Coaches to provide technical support to shortlisted applicants and grant recipients and (ii) Technical Experts to support the Fund Manager team in grant management process.

(i) Business Coaches

- Pre-grant coaching Support assigned applicants in developing their full proposal and business plans
 for IVACP grant according to the prescribed format and template through a consultative process.
 Coaches will work closely with the applicant's team through emails and virtual/in-person meetings to
 help in developing the project strategy, refining business plans and hand-holding for drafting of the
 proposal.
- 2. TA to grantees Provide technical assistance and expert advice to assigned selected grantees to address specific gaps in their capacities, strategic direction, and know-how based on an agreed Terms of Reference (TOR), and hand holding their growth process. These could be in the areas of technology integration, marketing, product development, business planning, business management supply chain management, branding and packaging, financial management, risk management, marketing, technology adoption and integration, access to finance, and technical advisory support in line with agroecology principles and practices.
- 3. TA to grantees will be delivered through expert guidance on specific areas, on-site visits, linkages/introductions to relevant stakeholders, support in negotiations, documentation etc., regular calls/meetings with the grantee, training workshops/sessions for grantee staff, and any means as agreed and as per identified need.

(ii) Technical Experts

Support the ACCESS Fund Manager team with technical expertise in various aspects of evaluating grant applications and monitoring progress of grantees. As part of this, the empanelled technical experts may be

assigned one or more of the following responsibilities for a one or more applicants/grantees through single/multiple contracts:

- 1. **Review and evaluation of grant applications:** Screen and review proposals and business plans for the grants with respect to their alignment with project objectives, technical soundness, and financial feasibility using the pre-decided evaluation metrics as documented in the Grant Fund Implementation Manual.
- 2. **Due diligence of shortlisted applicants:** Conduct on-site and off-site due diligence of short-listed applicants as per due diligence check lists and framework laid out in the Grant Fund Implementation Manual.
- 3. **Monitoring of grantees:** Conduct monitoring of assigned grantees through on-site visits to and off-site review of documents etc. for monitoring of progress on business plan, verification of technical aspects of integration of agroecological principles in product/process, verification of technology/equipment/infrastructure, and other relevant aspects as defined in the TOR.
- 4. **Technical backstopping:** Provide technical advice and support to the Fund Manager team on specific aspects related to agri and allied value chains including in processing/value addition, measurement of agroecological impact, access to markets for sustainable food systems, and other as per requirement and identified from time to time.

4. Qualification & Experience

The Consultant must be professionally qualified as MBA/ MBA- Rural Management/ PG in Rural Development/ MBA- Finance/ Marketing/ Masters in Agriculture or Allied / Food Processing/ Food Technology/ Social Work/ Ecology/ Environment or equivalent.

The Consultant must have experience of 8 years or more in the areas of agri/allied value chains, supporting livelihoods of small producers/small holder farmers, and a sound technical understanding of sustainable/agro ecological based production systems. Experience in one or more areas outlined below are expected:

- Preparation/ evaluation of business proposals in areas of Agriculture or Agriculture based Value Chain Projects, preparation of strategic business plans with financial projections, review and evaluation of project proposals, budget analysis and review of financial statements etc.
- Promoting/supporting Producer Collectives (Farmer Producer Organizations or other forms of agri and allied Producer Organizations
- Learning and capacity building workshops for POEs/ MSEs
- Experience in one or more relevant technical areas Agri business management, supply chain management, post-harvest management, value addition, processing, Agri marketing, Agri-technology, organic certification and other relevant areas

6. Period of Empanelment

Empanelment of business coaches and technical experts will be initially for a period of One (01) year with scope of extension in the next year subject to the performance and requirement in the project.

Specific time commitment of empanelled consultant will depend on profile of consultant and project requirements.

The application will be evaluated based on the credential of applicant on educational qualification including relevant technical qualification, nature and years of experience and technical credentials.
